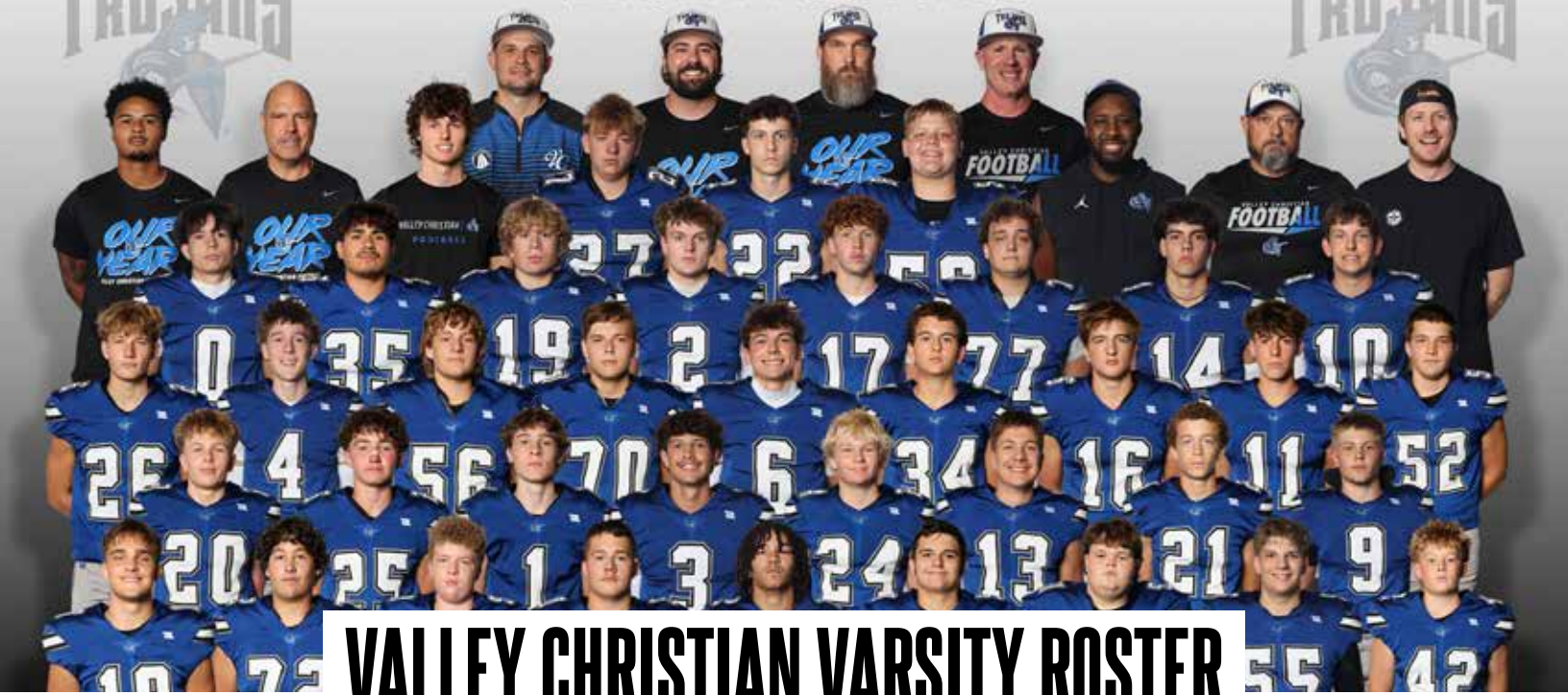

He ranks first in career wins (54) and win percentage (.857) among VC coaches. His teams averaged more points per game (41.4) during his tenure, the highest of any VC head coach. His 2009 state championship team averaged a school record 47.1 points per game in an era when games were called once a team was winning by 42 points.
